

Sunday School Teacher Responsibilities

1. Sunday School Teachers are to be respected by students and by parents as well as their children
2. Sunday School Teachers are to be in their classroom no less than 10 minutes early to greet their students. No student should be dropped off to an empty class
3. Sunday School Teachers are to attend Sunday school teachers meetings to learn and contribute
4. Sunday School Teachers are to prepare their lesson well as an offering to the Lord
5. Sunday School Teachers are to seek the approval of Sunday School superintendent or pastors before they ask someone to replace themselves
6. Sunday School Teachers are to start on time and to stop one time so as to respect other classes at all times considering things like noise
7. Sunday School Teachers are free to do their own bulletin boards and class decorations
8. Sunday School Teachers should record attendance for the Sunday School secretary
9. The pastors should be aware to some degree of the content of all materials taught to students
10. Any Sunday School involvement in parachurch ministries (Missions, Fund Raising, Gatherings) must be approved by pastors
11. In the absence of a Sunday School superintendent, teachers should be in regular contact with the pastors
12. Sunday School teachers should see themselves as undershepherds in that there is more to Sunday School than dispensing facts - we are in ministry; both to the class as a whole and to each individual
